

Teacher:

Cut out the green shapes for students to place on the green alphabet mat. If desired, laminate first, then attach hook and loop fasteners after cutting.

Allow students to place the shapes on the mat in a mixed-up order, then sing their silly song together! Students will enjoy designing their own alphabet song and the sound-alike structure will provide them an additional auditory cue to help them with letter identification as they sing.

For greater context and building prior knowledge, be sure to read the book, We Mix Up Our ABCs by Aaron Wills before using this activity.

Students who are confident with letter identification, might enjoy designing their alphabet song using the blue sheet with additional sound-alike structures.
